# A Receptive Heart

How can we prepare the ground of our heart to produce 100-fold harvest described by Jesus in Luke 8:5-15?

 *God gives His Word into the heart of an individual.*

Once we receive a word from God, whether sanctification, tithing, the Baptism of the Holy Spirit, purity, etc., it comes in a seed form to prepare the soil of our heart for a harvest. We can disregard it, however, the result is that our enemy will come and steal it away (V.5 the seed on the pathway).

There are times when we receive the seed with joy, excited about what God has expressed; but

when temptation comes, it falls away because of no root system (V.6 the seed in the rocks). Another receives the word but it is choked out because of the cares of the world, the deceitfulness of riches and the pleasures of life, which hinders the production of fruit (V.7 the seed in a weedy garden).

 *God requires us to have a fruitful life.*

When the word comes from God, we must remove those rocks out of our heart. 1 Peter 5:7, "Cast all your cares upon Him for He cares for you."

The goal is "good soil" (a receptive heart). Soft and prudent with forthcoming cares of this life. Let God have control as He leads and teaches you through His word. Luke 8:15, "But the ones that

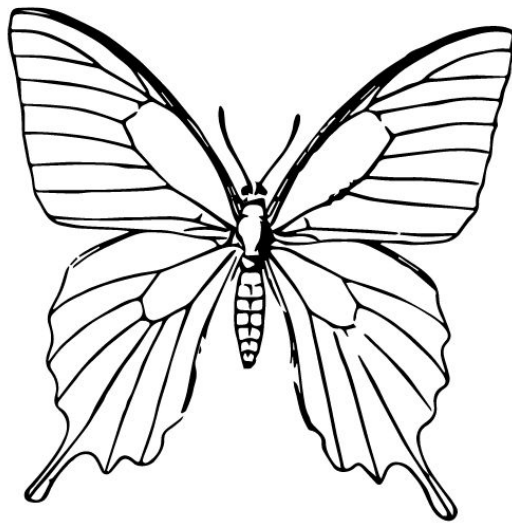
fell on the good ground are those who, having heard the Word with a noble and good heart, keep it and bear fruit with patience."

It's a lifetime of learning to hear from God and then obeying. Eliminating the hardness of heart and daily weeding out anything that will choke out the Word of God.

# National Applesauce Cake Day

June 6th is National Applesauce Cake Day. This tasty applesauce cake offers an opportunity to share a slice (or two) of a cake that comes in a variety of recipes. My favorite, is one my grandmother used to make: Spiced Apple cake.

The recipe is from my grandmothers' cookbook from 1938. I was gifted this book of memories when she went to heaven. I remember baking with her so many times and using recipes from this cookbook.

Many of us have experience in cooking and baking. Sometimes we even forgo using a recipe. Still, we must follow particular sets of instructions to ensure we get continuity and the best taste from our culinary creations.

The word of God can be compared to a recipe. There are no secret ingredients, just a faith in Jesus Christ. The apostle Paul gave us some ingredients for a better, more fulfilling life in Christ. Here is his recipe for an effective and productive life, it comes from the Bible.



*Begin with a personal relationship with Jesus.  
Romans 10:9 This is so important.*



*Add goodness, self control and perseverance in equal amounts. Galatians 5:22, 23.*



*Stir in wisdom and knowledge.  
1 Corinthians 2:5*



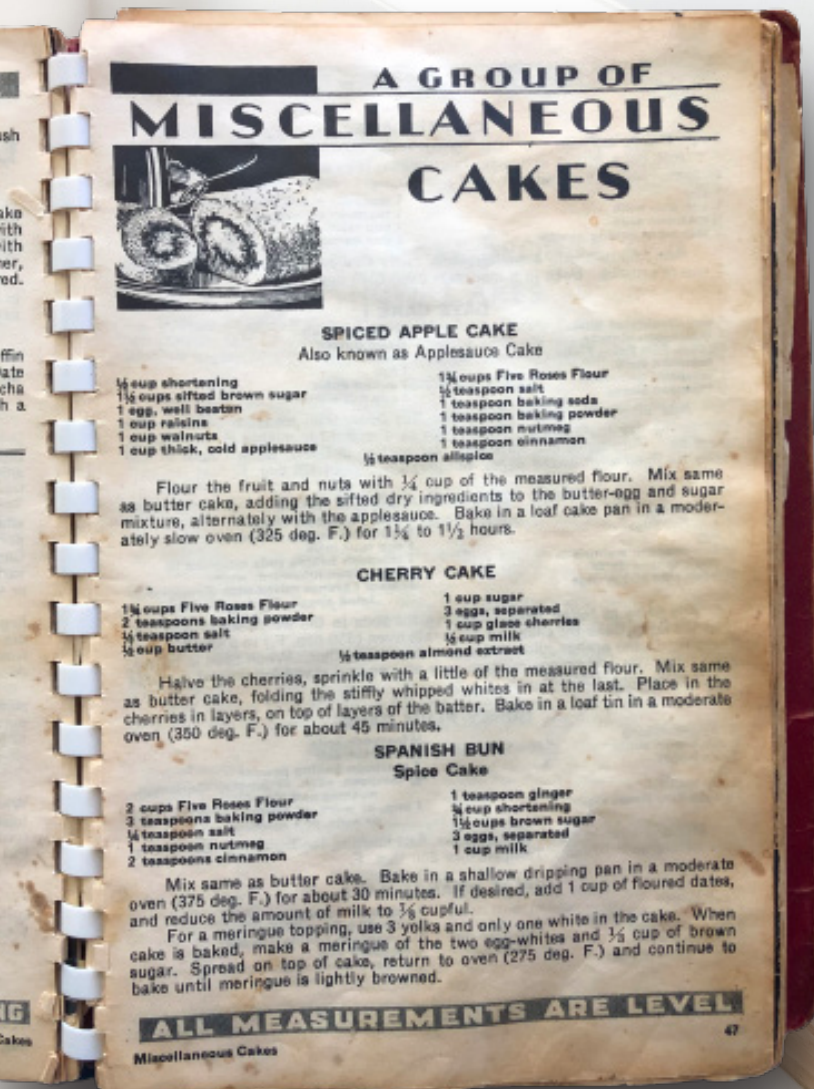
*Mix thoroughly and bake with an abundance of love. 1 Corinthians 13:13*

## A GROUP OF MISCELLANEOUS CAKES



### SPICED APPLE CAKE

Also known as Applesauce Cake

$\frac{1}{2}$  cup shortening  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  cups sifted brown sugar  
1 egg, well beaten  
1 cup raisins  
1 cup walnuts  
1 cup thick, cold applesauce  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  teaspoon allspice  
 $1\frac{1}{2}$  cups Five Roses Flour  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  teaspoon salt  
1 teaspoon baking soda  
1 teaspoon nutmeg  
1 teaspoon cinnamon

Flour the fruit and nuts with  $\frac{1}{4}$  cup of the measured flour. Mix same as butter cake, adding the sifted dry ingredients to the butter-egg and sugar mixture, alternately with the applesauce. Bake in a loaf cake pan in a moderately slow oven (325 deg. F.) for  $1\frac{1}{4}$  to  $1\frac{1}{2}$  hours.

### CHERRY CAKE

$1\frac{1}{2}$  cups Five Roses Flour  
2 teaspoons baking powder  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  teaspoon salt  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  cup butter  
1 cup sugar  
3 eggs, separated  
1 cup glacé cherries  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  cup milk  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  teaspoon almond extract

Halve the cherries, sprinkle with a little of the measured flour. Mix same as butter cake, folding the stiffly whipped whites in at the last. Place in the cherries in layers, on top of layers of the batter. Bake in a loaf tin in a moderate oven (350 deg. F.) for about 45 minutes.

### SPANISH BUN

Spice Cake

2 cups Five Roses Flour  
2 teaspoons baking powder  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  teaspoon salt  
1 teaspoon nutmeg  
2 teaspoons cinnamon  
1 teaspoon ginger  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  cup shortening  
 $1\frac{1}{2}$  cups brown sugar  
3 eggs, separated  
1 cup milk

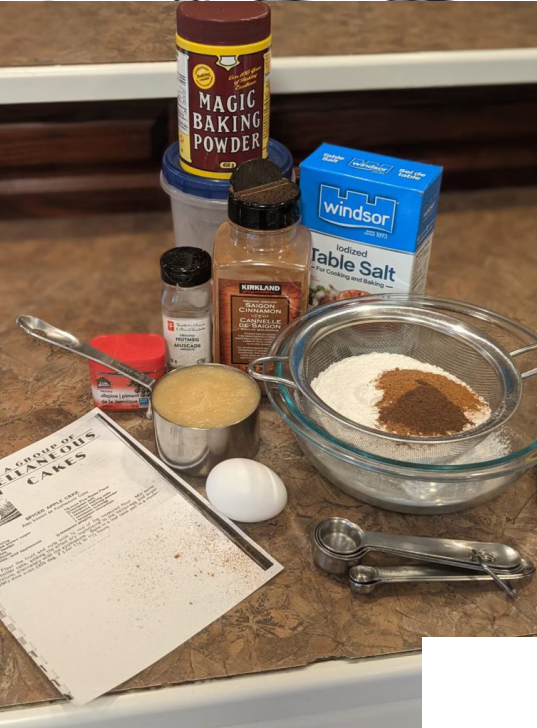
Mix same as butter cake. Bake in a shallow dripping pan in a moderate oven (375 deg. F.) for about 30 minutes. If desired, add 1 cup of floured dates, and reduce the amount of milk to  $\frac{1}{2}$  cupful.

For a meringue topping, use 3 yolks and only one white in the cake. When cake is baked, make a meringue of the two egg-whites and  $\frac{1}{2}$  cup of brown sugar. Spread on top of cake, return to oven (275 deg. F.) and continue to bake until meringue is lightly browned.

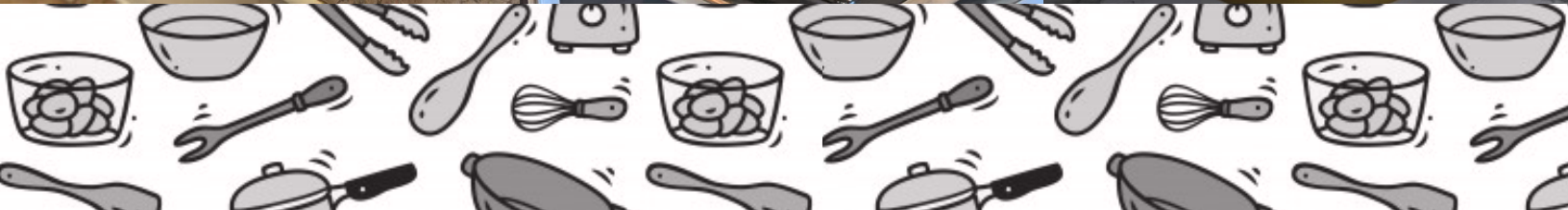

Taken from the book-Meeting God by Judson Cornwall

“Adam’s undefiled relationship with God preserved a childlike trust. Adam could trust himself, so it was easy for him to trust God. Since everything that God said, proved to be true and every commitment made was fulfilled explicitly, trust in God was automatic and continuous.” (pg16).

“But Adam’s knowledge of God was further enhanced by his constant communication with God. God and Adam used to walk together in the garden of Eden and talk about plants, animals, birds and fish. God was the only instructor Adam knew. Theirs was not a classroom setting; it was a Father-son walk in the garden. Adam learned about life from

God and in the process, he learned about God. What wonder and awe must have filled Adam’s mind as he listened to God during those daily walks in the cool of the evening.” (pg. 17).

Charismatic Christian preacher, pastor, and author of over 50 books on varied subjects such as worship, praise, spiritual warfare, and death. A third-generation minister, Judson Cornwall was preaching at the age of 7 during the Depression era, and later was regarded as an apostle and pioneer. Three of his books, Let Us Worship, Elements of Worship, and Let Us Praise, are widely considered Christian classics. You can find his books on Amazon.

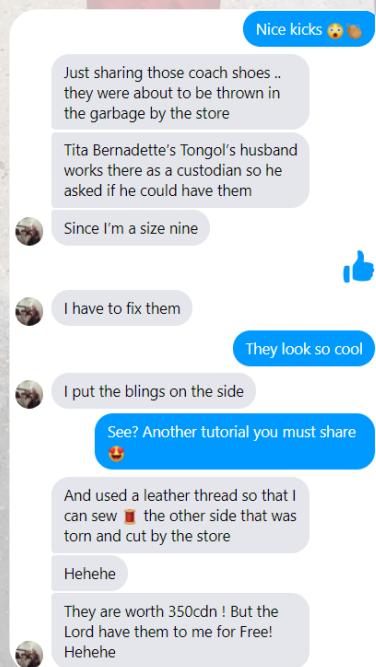

**Complete your summer party**, barbecue or picnic with a sweet, refreshing pitcher of sparkling strawberry lemonade, made with real fruit!

### Ingredients

1 cup water  
½ cup granulated sugar  
1 cup freshly squeezed lemon juice  
2 cups strawberries, stems removed  
4 cups sparkling water

### Instructions

1. In a medium saucepan, bring 1 cup of water to a boil. Add sugar and stir until dissolved. Stir in lemon juice and remove

from heat. Let mixture cool completely.

2. Blend 1 and ½ cups strawberries until smooth. Remove and strain through a fine mesh sieve if desired.

3. Whisk strawberry puree, sugar mixture, and sparkling water together in a large pitcher.

4. Place in refrigerator until completely cool.

5. Slice remaining strawberries and add to lemonade. Add ice and serve!

### Notes

For a non-carbonated water, simply substitute the sparkling water with regular water.
